Two Funding Opportunities for Diabetes Coalitions in the Appalachian Region

The first funding opportunity is for established coalitions, called Together on Diabetes. This funding will enable coalitions to implement evidence-based programs for physical activity and healthy eating that reach the whole county. The RFP outlines the eligibility criteria. This will be a competitive grant application. Five grants will be awarded. The funding amount is \$40,000 per year for four years. <u>Click here for more information</u>.

The second funding opportunity is for new or emerging coalitions that have not been funded in the past. These planning grants aim to help establish or strengthen diabetes coalitions. The grants funds can be used for organizing events, publicity and training events. Marshall will also provide in-depth planning and technical assistance as part of the grant. The funding amount is \$2,000. Eight planning grants will be awarded. Please refer to the RFP for eligibility criteria. <u>Click here for more information</u>.

These funding opportunities are a partnership between the Appalachian Regional Commission, the Division of Diabetes Translation at the Center for Disease Control, and the Bristol-Myers Squibb Foundation. The project is managed by the Center for Rural Health at Marshall University School of Medicine.

April, 4, 2013 – The U.S. Commercial Service, Southern Ohio District Export Council, and Xavier University will be hosting the 7th **Annual International Trade Conference** in Cincinnati, Ohio. This year's conference will focus on the "hot markets" of India, Indonesia, Russia, and South Korea and will provide market updates, tools, and resources for U.S. companies interested in selling to or expanding into these countries.

Update! The Ohio International Market Access Grant for Exporters (IMAGE) program is accepting applications! IMAGE is a program funded by the State of Ohio and the U.S. Small Business Administration as part of the National Export Initiative to double U.S. exports by 2015. This program is designed to increase exports and create jobs by helping small businesses to promote their products and services in new international markets. Ohio has received additional funding for this program that will extend until September 30, 2013. There are updates to the program including increased reimbursement amounts and activities covered. Qualifying Ohio companies can apply for up to **50% financial reimbursement** to offset the costs of export-related activities such as: international trade show participation, subscription to services provided by the U.S. Commercial Service, export education programs, marketing and translation services, and international trade mission participation. Appalachian companies are eligible for almost **65% financial reimbursement** on the same activities.
