The Ohio Department of Transportation (ODOT) began accepting funding request applications on January 1st for Transportation Alternatives, Small City, and Municipal Bridge projects. The programs provide fed-

Transportation Alternatives Program – Federal funding is available for the construction of bicycle and pedestrian transportation and recreational facilities, projects or systems to aid non-drivers to access daily needs, traffic calming solutions, turnouts and overlooks to access significant scenic or historic sites and

projects that preserve historic transportation facilities throughout Ohio. Local governments outside the boundaries of Metropolitan Planning Organizations (MPOs) are eligible for program funding. Additionally, local governments and transportation authorities within Allen, Belmont, Licking and Washington counties that are within an MPO region can also apply to receive project funding. The funding will be provided for

Small City Program - The Small City Program provides federal funds to cities with populations from 5,000 to 24,999 and that are not within an MPO boundary. Currently, there are 58 Small Cities statewide that meet these criteria. This program may be used by the incorporated localities for any roadway or safety project on the Federal-aid system. The funding will be provided for projects to be awarded in State Fiscal Year 2015-2016. A list of eligible cities, program guidance and application can be found on the ODOT Office of Local programs website at: http://www.dot.state.oh.us/Divisions/Planning/LocalPrograms/Pages/ SmallCity.aspx Municipal Bridge Program - The Municipal Bridge Program provides federal funds to municipal corporations for bridge replacement or bridge rehabilitation projects. Bridges must carry vehicular traffic to be eligible for funding. Bridges that exist solely for railroad or pedestrian facilities are not eligible for fund-

ing. The funding will be provided for projects to be awarded in State Fiscal Year 2016-2017. A list of bridges targeted for funding, program guidance and application can be found on the ODOT Office of Local

Safe Routes to School (SRTS) Sign Program: ODOT has standard school zone signs available for K-8 schools in Ohio. If a community needs to replace existing standard school zone signs, and has the forces to do so themselves, ODOT can offer signs at no charge to the community. Click Here for order form. The community does not need to be a part of an existing SRTS program. These signs are meant to improve safety quickly for communities across the state. Click Here for sign program procedures.
