- On April 18, 2013 Appalachian Ohio Geospatial Data Partnership (AOGDP), OVRDC GIS User Group, and Southwest Ohio GIS (SWOGIS) User Group held a joint meeting at The Ohio State University Endeavor Center in Piketon, Ohio.
- In 2012 Gallia County, Coshocton County and AOGDP proposed a regional Geographic Information System (GIS) project called the Appalachian Ohio's Open Geographic Information System Web Access that leverages the benefits of a shared resource. This project is funded through State of Ohio Local Government Innovation Fund Grant (LGIF) between Gallia County, Ohio University Voinovich Center, Buckeye Hills-Hocking Valley Regional Development District and Ohio Valley Regional Development Commission. This is a GIS feasibility project to determine the most effective means with which to design and maintain a web mapping service that will allow counties to publish their parcel data on the web and make it available to a wide audience.  - Always looking for new and exciting speakers to come speak at the meetings.

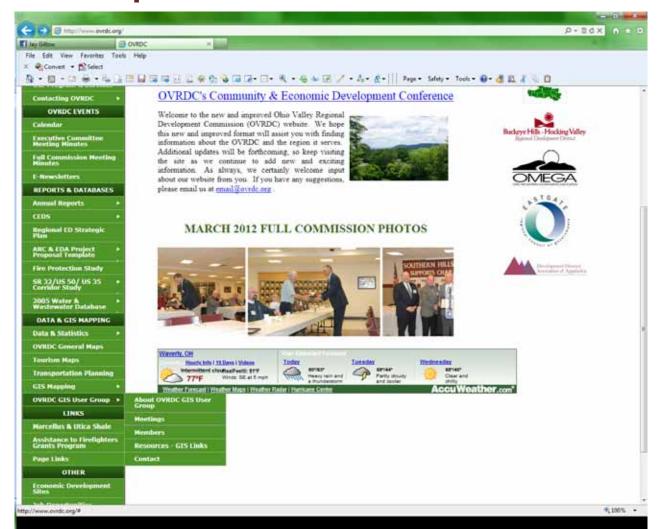


- OVRDC GIS Regional GIS Projects
